

Stand Watie (1806 - 1871) was a controversial leader of the Cherokee Nation. He was partly responsible for the removal of the Cherokee Nation to a reservation in Oklahoma. He was a slave owner and joined the Confederacy during the Civil War.

Rising to the rank of brigadier general, Watie fought alongside Earl Van Dorn at the Battle of Pea Ridge in Northwest Arkansas.
