In your own words describe your artistic practice. Provide a written response (max 300 words) describing your work, your primary motivation for creating work, and/or projects and accomplishments you're excited about. *Option to submit an audio/video

□ What do you want your arts career to look like five years from now? How do you think the Artist INC program will advance your practice and/or career?

In your own words, share your goals and aspirations for your career, where do you see your arts career five years from now? Provide a written response (max 300 words). *Option to submit an audio/video
