DESCRIPTION
The Bolin Barn, c. 1930, is rectangular in plan with a gambrel roof. It is of frame construction and clad with weatherboard. The two-story structure has a shingle roof with a bay hood and two cupolas for ventilation. There is also an elaborate "trellislike" ventilation system just below the eaves, around the whole barn. The barn is in a deteriorated condition. The smokehouse, c. 1890, is of box construction with a board and batten exterior and a tin roof. Typical of the smokehouse form, there is a projecting front gable; however, a more unique feature is the below-grade root cellar.
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE
Criterion: C Area of significance: Architecture
Both the Bolin barn and smokehouse are significant for their rather unique architectural design. It is very probable that the ventilation system on the barn is unique in the state. Although it is not unique, the combined smokehouse and root cellar is far from common.
