

DESCRIPTION
Comprised of house and six outbuildings, the Gailey Hollow Farmstead is located in rural Benton County near the Logan community. The house is T-shaped, one-and-onehalf stories with traditional double pen facade and side gables. A wide fourwindow dormer pierces the roof of the facade, and the side elevations are distinguished by a trio of windows on the lower level and a single window in the gable. Shed-roofed screen porches are attached to both sides of the rear $T$. The house is sheathed in weatherboard and all windows are two-over-two double-hung. Also included on the property are a smoke house, a garage, a barn, a grain crib, a carriage house and a chicken house.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Gailey Hollow Famstead, although in deteriorated condition, survives intact and is significant as a collection of buildings which exhibit characteristics typical of an early twentieth century famstead. The number of outbuildings remaining and the integrity and detail-chamfered posts, ornamental screen doors-of the house make it a significant architectural resource unique to the area.
