DESCRIPTION

The Duckworth-Williams House is a two-story English Tudor Revival residence. It is covered in stucco over brick construction, with an abundance of half-timbering on all elevations. A side-gable roof with a shed dormer extends to cover a full-length recessed front porch, which is supported by stuccoed piers. Windows are three-overone, double-hung. The house sits on a large lot above the Siloam Springs City Park and features nicely landscaped grounds.
