Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of the western edge of State Highway 109 with a perpendicular line running parallel with the northern end of the bridge and located approximately 25 feet to the north thereof, proceed westerly for a distance of approximately 25 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line running parallel with the bridge's western side; thence proceed southerly along said line for a distance of approximately 323 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed easterly along said line for a distance of approximately 74 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed northerly along said line for a distance of approximately 323 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed northerly along said line for a distance of approximately 323 feet to its intersection with a perpendicular line; thence proceed southwesterly to the point of beginning.

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Description

Located on Highway 109 at its crossing of the Petit Jean River (approximately .5 miles south of County Road 738 and Highway 109, approximately one mile north of Sugar Creek), the Petit Jean River Bridge is a Pratt through-truss steel bridge. The bridge itself extends between two pair of poured concrete piers placed away from each shoreline and which connect the bridge structure itself with the approach spans. The entire bridge measures 273 feet in length, with a deck width of 19 feet and an overall width of 24 feet. The abutments that support the ends of the approach spans are stone masonry and the piers are concrete. The deck material is timber over a steel substructure. A simple metal handrailing also runs the length of each side of the deck.

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Significance

Constructed in 1938, the Petit Jean River Bridge is associated with the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Era historic context and is of the steel Pratt through-truss type. Though the identity of its original designer does not survive, it was constructed in conjunction with the Arkansas State Highway Commission and thus may well have been designed by one of that state agency's engineers. Given its relatively intact condition it retains sufficient integrity to remain associated with its historic period and is thus locally eligible under Criterion C.
