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#### **DESCRIPTION**

Located on Sellars Street, formerly Main Street, at the point where it crosses the Silver Smith Branch, the Main Street Bridge is of the closed-spandrel stone-masonry arch type. The bridge is a single span bridge constructed of locally quarried stone. The bridge's total length is 19 feet with a width of approximately 20 feet. The arch is constructed entirely of stone, as is the deck with its dirt and gravel surface. The bridge was constructed in two sections, with the south portion being completed first. The bridge has not been altered since its construction in 1922.

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#### **SUMMARRY**

Constructed in 1922, the Main Street Bridge over Silver Smith Branch in New Blaine, Arkansas, is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places with local significance under Criterion C as the best example of a stone masonry bridge in the town and surrounding area. It is being submitted under the multiple property listing "Architectural Resources of New Blaine, Arkansas" in conjunction with the historic context "History and Architecture of New Blaine, Arkansas: 1920-1940".

#### **ELABORATION**

The Main Street Bridge is located on Sellars Street in New Blaine, Arkansas. The bridge spans Silver Smith Branch. The branch gets its name from a gentleman named Smith who came to the area to prospect for silver. After having some luck in the branch's water, he set up a small business selling silver bracelets and spoons. The branch took on the name Silver Smith Branch after Mr. Smith started his business.

Then the bridge was built Sellars Street was Main Street, hence the bridge's name. The bridge was built in 1922 as the town of New Blaine was beginning to flourish. A wood bridge had crossed Silver Smith Branch, but as the commercial area begin to thrive with the arrival of the railroad, the townspeople saw the need for a more durable bridge to handle the increased flow of people and goods to and from the depot.

Local stonemasons Steve Robinson and Freeborn Lasater constructed the bridge under the supervision of Aaron Moore. The bridge was constructed in two phases. The south half was completed first, then the wood bridge was removed and the north half of the stone bridge was then completed. The bridge was the primary route of entry into the town's commercial area and depot.

The bridge has continuously been used since its construction in 1922. It has survived both time and nature. In 1927 the railroad was disabled when floodwaters destroyed the nearby trestle. The stone bridge was unharmed by the raging waters.

Today, the Logan County Road Department maintains the bridge. Although traffic over the bridge has dramatically decreased since the town's heyday in the 1920s, the bridge still performs a vital task to those who live in the former commercial area of New Blaine.

### Statement of Significance

Constructed in 1922, the Main Street Bridge over Silver Smith Branch in New Blaine, Arkansas, is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places with local significance under Criterion C as the best ample of a stone masonry bridge in the town and surrounding area. It is being submitted under the multiple property listing "Architectural Resources of New Blaine, Arkansas" in conjunction with the historic context "History and Architecture of New Blaine, Arkansas: 1920-1940".




