



#### Physical Description

Large elm trees shade this two-story frame house designed by Charles Thompson and located on a corner lot on Broadway, once a two lane boulevard and now one of Little Rock's main thoroughfares. The high brick foundation accentuates the vertical proportions of the familiar boxy house with three bays. Here the steep gable end roof is punctuated by two gable roof dormers. The ends of the full length front porch are supported by large granite piers, while two fluted columns with simple capitals and bases support the center section. Aside from the fluted columns decoration consists almost entirely of the generous use of diamond window panes which appear in dormers, the centrally located second story windows, the sidelights and transom of the plate glass front door and the upper panes of the first story windows. Adjacent to the front door on the south, French doors with a diamond pane transom open onto the porch. The gable ends feature pseudo half-timbering. The house is faced with narrow weatherboards on the second story, with wider ones below.

### Statement of Significance

Designed by Charles L. Thompson ca. 1910, the Vaughan House at 2201 Broadway in Little Rock is another variation of the firm's standard two-story, three-bay designs of frame construction. However, the Vaughan House, located on Little Rock's historic Broadway Street, is more vertical in orientation than many of the other similar houses. The verticality of the house is accented with the abundant use of diamond window panes, which appear in virtually all apertures on the Vaughan House. A high brick foundation and steep gable roof add to the vertical proportions of the house. Familiar to other Thompson designs, the Vaughan House features a full length front porch. This unique porch features large granite piers on either end of the porch, perhaps providing necessary visual balance to the design's verticality, while the central section has more delicate appearing fluted columns.
