## ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The Stegall General Store is part of Mountain View's contiguous streetscape of native stone commercial store facades that form the south side of the courthouse square. Built in 1926, this traditional one story rectangular structure is constructed of load bearing stone walls and covered with a flat roof. Symmetrically designed, the dressed stone storefront exhibits a central entrance and two flanking display windows. Large stationary wood framed panes placed on stone lintels, with multi-light transoms, form the two windows. The main entry is comprised of double doors, each featuring a multi-light over wood panel design, and surmounted by a multi-light transom. The building's unadorned massed stone entablature, finished with stone coping, completes the principal facade.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Stegall General Store, like the A. B. Brewer Building, was constructed by the Brewer Brothers and represents the dominating building scale of the square. The store was built in 1926 during Mountain View's second stage of stone construction around the square. The Stegall General Store is part of Mountain View's modest contiguous streetscape of stone commercial building that form the south side of the courthouse square.


