DESCRIPTION

The Bogart Hardware Building is a two-story four-bay commercial front. The all-brick second floor facade is supported by cast iron columns and beams across an otherwise all-glass ground floor facade. Two doors penetrate the ground floor front; a shop entrance at the second bay from the right (west) and an entry to the second floor stairway at the extreme left of the building. The four windows of the second floor have two-over-two double-hung sash and are spanned by unadorned brick segmental arches. A lively corbelled brick cornice gives definition to the roof line.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C Area of significance: Architecture


The Bogart Hardware Building, built c. 1880, has maintained its architectural integrity for more than a century. This building and its neighbors to the west remain the least disturbed or modified business fronts in the Bentonville business district. Only faded light paint on this facade tends to diminish the three-dimensional quality of the corbelled brick cornice.
