Harris Flanagin (1817-1874) was the seventh governor of the state of Arkansas. Flanagin was a politician, lawyer and member of the state secession convention in 1861. Flanagin served as an officer in the Confederate Army before being elected governor of Confederate Arkansas in 1862. His term as governor was cut short by the fall of the Confederacy and the end of the Civil War in 1865.
