

Susan Cook (1842-1912) of Phillips County, Arkansas, was nineteen when the Civil War broke out. Her family consisted of planters who backed the Confederacy. She kept a diary about what she heard concerning the conflict, giving us firsthand knowledge of what people thought and did during the Civil War. Her words reflected her fading optimism for the Confederacy as it became apparent the South was fighting a losing battle.
